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Approach to project activities

- international dimension-five countries involved
- multiple actors-six institutions involved
- project activities content materials developed jointly with considerations of country specifics
- implementation of activities methodologically standardized

Approach to project activities (cont)

- e-platform for learning; teaching and learning materials for trainings and seminars available at e-classroom for all participants (teachers, volunteers, school directors...)
- materials for learning available in all national languages at e-classroom
- diversity of participants involved in project activities-students, teachers, school and civil society representatives

RoMigSc Project Impact

- **Training for volunteers**

- increasing the capacity of stakeholders to work more effectively
- avoiding conflict situations

- **Volunteering activity**

- helping society in overcoming the challenge
