- peer facilitated workshops on relevant topics

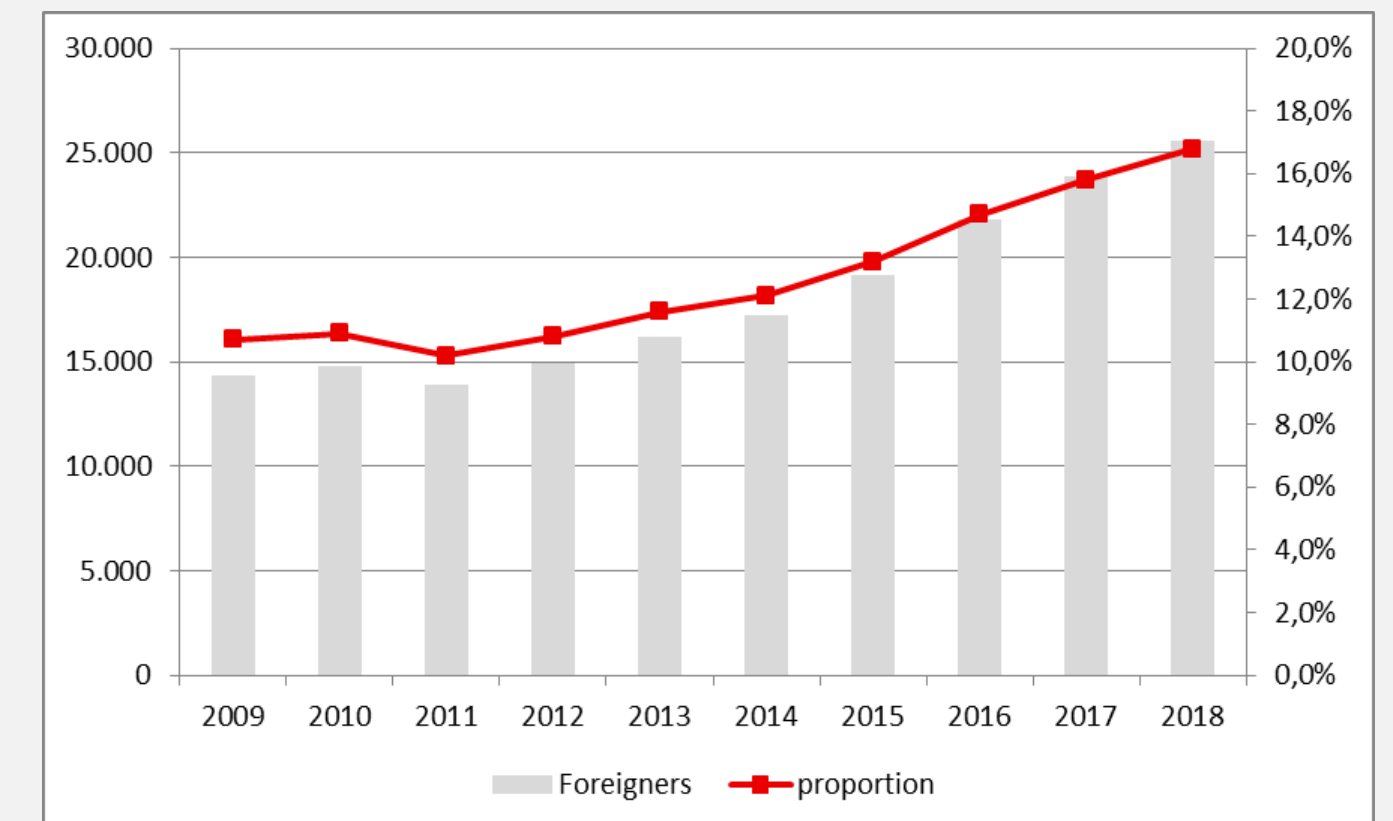
Adults (Age 25-...)

9 language schools and additional tutorial German lessons, 2 h once a week at vhs

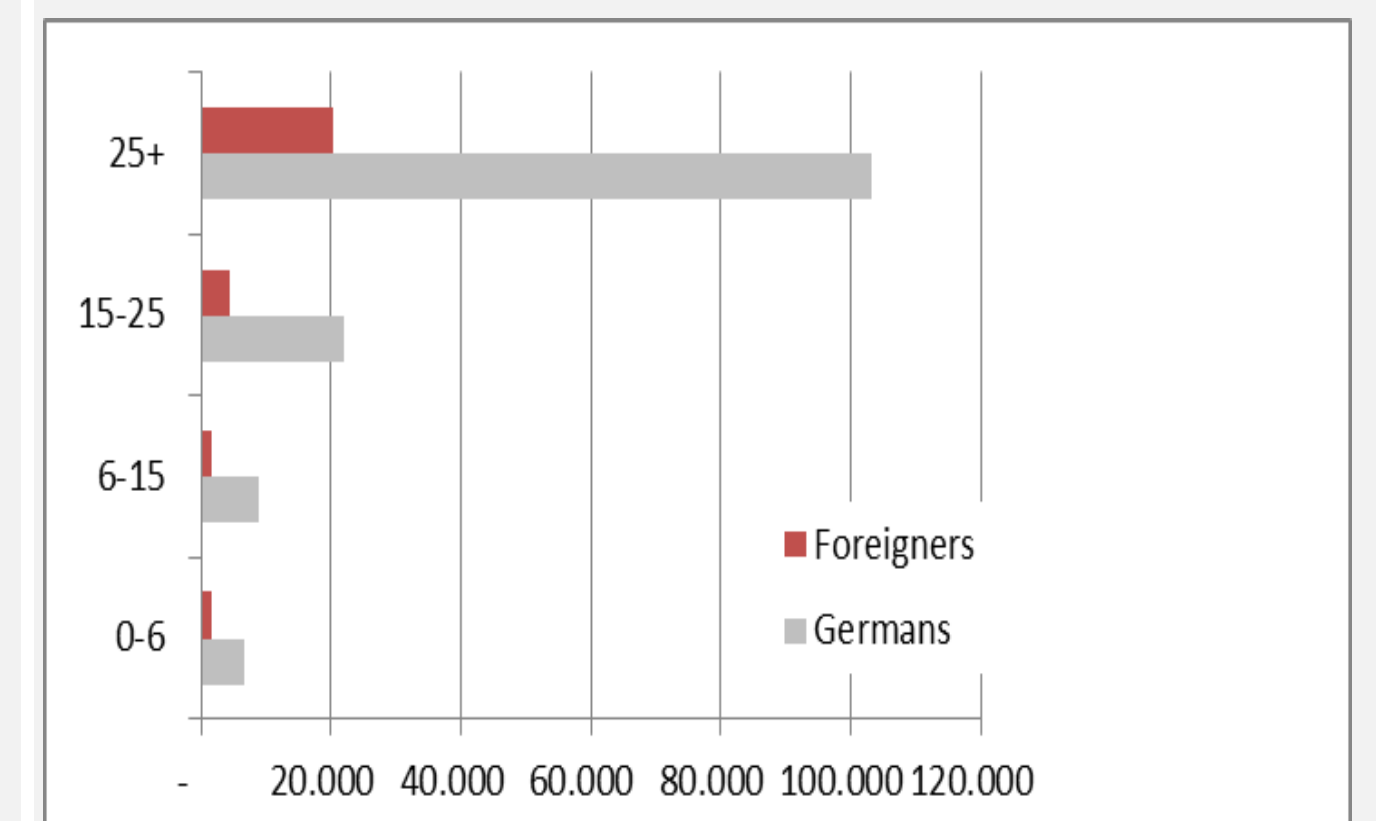
Adult education centre
