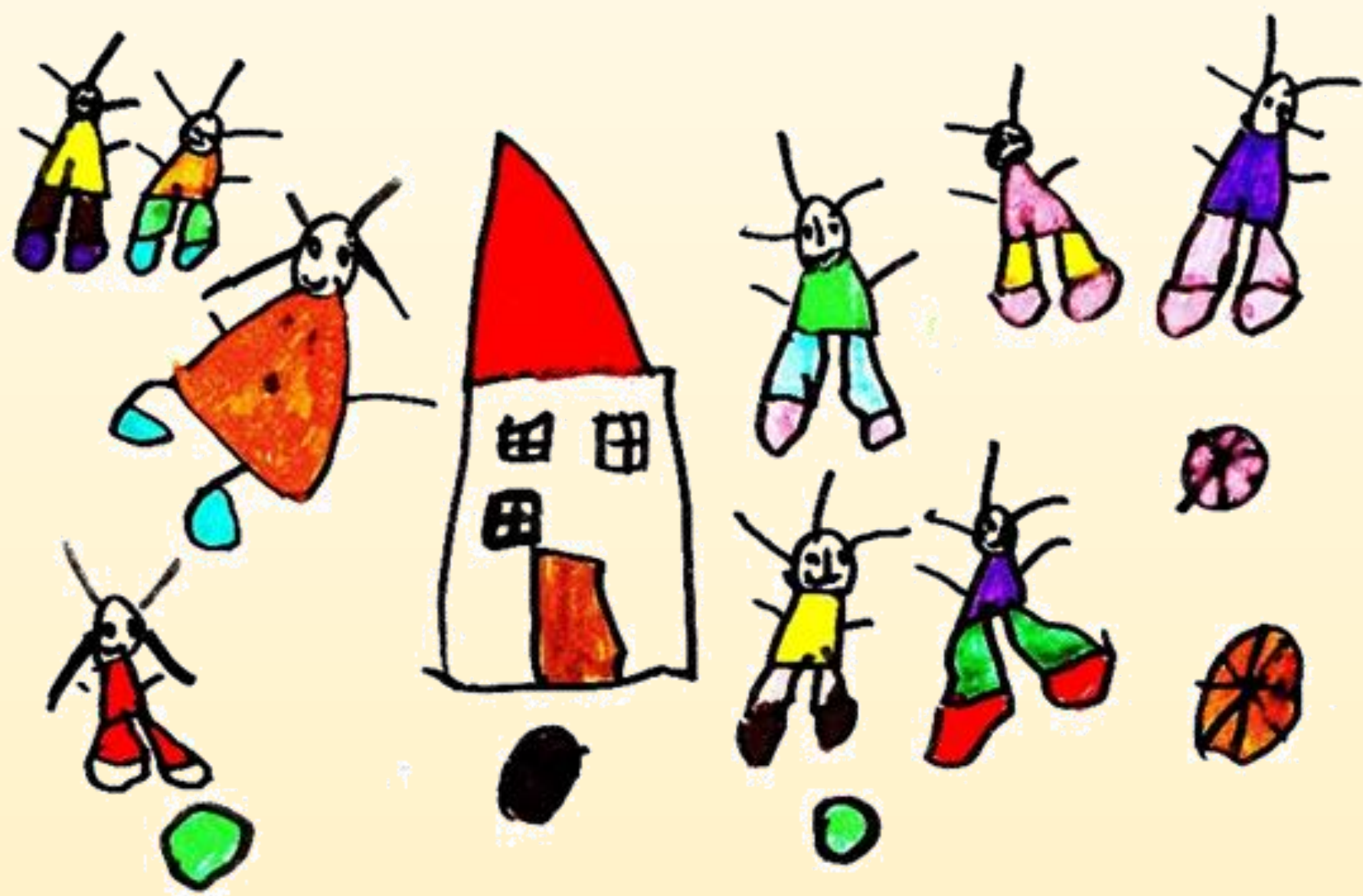


# Kindergarten Romano, Slovenia



## Key features

The kindergarten, which is now attended by Roma and non-Roma children, has made a significant contribution to the socialization and integration of Roma, and **represents a remarkable interaction between Roma and non-Roma children.**

In kindergarten Pušča are 2 sections, with children:

- from 1 – 4 years old
- from 4 – 6 years old

## Background

Kindergarten **Romano** is unit of Kindergarten Murska Sobota, located in Roma settlement Pušča.

Established in 1957, as **first Roma Kindergarten in Slovenia**, with the aim of early inclusion of Roma children in preschool education.

Until 2011 only Roma children were enrolled in the unit. Kindergarten Romano is now recognised as multicultural kindergarten, attended by Roma and non- Roma children.
